Homekey Round 2 Project: **Approved** for The Grove in Arcata

Homekey Round 2 grant recipients were announced Thursday April 14th, 2022, approving Arcata House Partnership, (AHP), to acquire the Days Inn to be used for permanent housing. This project follows Homekey 1, where AHP, in partnership with Yurok Indian Housing Authority, created a permanent housing site called Ke-my-ak' Place. Ke-my-ak, meaning 'I am home,' is an 18 unit affordable housing project in Eureka that is now operational and occupied. This new project will provide 60 units of affordable housing for individuals and families in the community who are currently homeless. Throughout the project timeline Arcata House Partnership would like to involve and update the community through website updates, open dialogue and community meetings. There will be two meetings that will be held June 18th & August 20th, 10am-11am in the AHP administration parking lot beside the Days Inn at 4677 Valley West Blvd.

The completed complex will be called 'The Grove,' and will include 24hr security and support. On-site supportive services will provide necessary services with counseling offices and space for supportive services and connection to other resources will be available to all tenants. The property will also include an office and storage area for the on-site manager. In the location of the existing covered pool structure, there will be a community building with amenities utilized for property management resident services. AHP is incredibly excited to be starting this project and looks forward to sharing progress and success with the community.

Safe parking Program Up and Running!

The safe Parking Program is open and operating. Contact the Annex for more information and enrollment question.

The Safe Parking short term shelter program is providing a safe space for families and individuals currently living in their vehicles. The program is designed to serve up to 30 vehicles at a time and give people a place to stay safely while they search for permanent housing. This program provides access to hygiene stations, water and daily meals so people can focus on their saving and housing goals without worrying about basic human needs. The Safe Parking Program is unique, offering security and access to services while allowing for individuals and families to keep their pets and belongings. Though the stay is short, one month for each vehicle, the access to services and connection to other programs provides a path towards permanent housing and a place to call home.

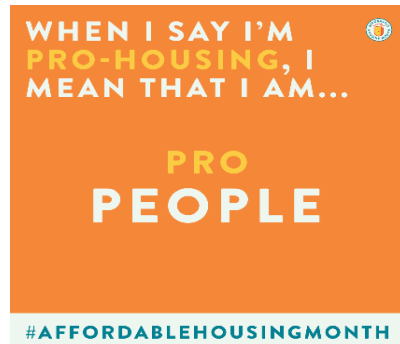
There are **44** low income housing apartment communities offering **1,894** affordable apartments for rent in Humboldt County, California.
